

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES FOR INDIA VOICE FEST AWARDS 2022.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY.

1. Purchasing a ticket for the event is mandatory to submit your work for India Voice Fest Awards 2022.

2. The Awards are open to Indian Citizens holding a valid Citizenship Identification Document (Voter ID, PAN Card or Aadhar Card)

3. The awards are open for work that has been BROADCAST between the 3rd of October 2021 and 2nd October 2022.

4. The entries are accepted for the mentioned categories only.

5. **ONLY professional & commercial voice recordings** that have been broadcast are accepted as Award entries.

6. The organisers may conduct a random check of the validity of work/ entry by multiple means including connecting with the client and/or checking online records of the broadcast.

7. **ONLY .MP4 or .MP3 or .WAV formats will be accepted** in the entries. We will NOT BE accepting any WEB LINKS.(no Google drive/ One drive links)

8. **An INDIVIDUAL can submit a MAXIMUM of TWO entries per category** irrespective of any language in that category. For example, one can submit a maximum of two entries in TVC Voiceover category. It could be both entries in Hindi or any other language, or one entry each in any two languages in the category.

9. **An INDIVIDUAL can submit a MAXIMUM of TEN** entries in all, irrespective of categories or languages!

10. **Each file size of content submitted for the Awards needs to be less than 100 MB in size.**

11. A minimum number of 4 valid entries are required for the organisers to **establish the respective category and language** for the awards.

12. In the event of non-receipt of a minimum number of entries in a particular language, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the award for that particular language/category/gender.

13. The organizers reserve the right to do a thorough check of the details mentioned in the entries including, verifying client and broadcast details. In case of any discrepancy, the organizers reserve the right to declare such entries void and not offer any further explanation on the same.

14. **The Awards presentation ceremony will be held on Sunday, 11th December at Rangsharda Auditorium.** It will be mandatory for the nominees to be present in the live event so that the winner from the nominees can come up on stage and accept the award.

15. Please ensure that you do not provide your NAME or name slate in the audio or video submission. If done so, the entry will be considered invalid.

16. The awards process involves an esteemed jury which will go through the valid submission and give marks on the basis of pre-decided criteria. For each category, an average of marks from the relevant jury members of that particular category will be taken for final points tally and the submission with the highest average number of marks will be the winner of the said award.

17. The jury decision will be final and without prejudice.
